


From hypertension to diabetes to housing to food access, Wellness West is measurably improving the health and wellness of thousands of patients on Chicago's West Side. Here are some results so far.

Who We Are

The West Side of Chicago suffers disproportionately from higher rates of chronic disease, acute ailments and mental illness. Wellness West was created to address this health inequity. Wellness West is the coming together of proven, well-respected health care and social service providers on the West Side. Our purpose is to create an unprecedented collaboration for the uninterrupted continuity of care among hospitals, outpatient care, the social service network and community residents. We work in 10 West Side zip codes with those on Medicaid or who have no health insurance, focusing on several chronic care and behavioral conditions.
